Who are the Friends?

The mission of the Friends is to raise funds, promote, and advocate on behalf of the Haverford Township Free Library.

The Friends:

- Provide significant funds for library acquisitions, programs and services.
- Stimulate greater interest and use of the library.
- Ensure the existence of the library for years to come.

Active since 2003, The Friends of the Haverford Township Free Library is a volunteer, 501(c)3 non-profit organization devoted to helping the library enrich the lives of community residents.

Friends' contributions since inception

Since 2003, Friends' contributions have totaled more than \$255,000.

Fundraising results in 2018

This was not as strong a year for fundraising as 2017, with total funds raised declining from \$29,652 to \$21,250, a drop of \$8,402. The primary causes for this reduction were:

- The lack of a Silent Auction which grossed **\$6,800** in 2017
- Fall and Summer Book Sales took in \$7,066 versus \$8,488 in 2017, a drop of \$1,422
- Dues declined from \$5,300 to \$4,579, a drop of \$721

The biggest bright spot was the Book Bundle sale, which surged from \$344 in 2017 to \$887 in 2018.

Members of the Friends

A significant source of funding is your membership dues. In 2018, there were 99 members.
